

Athlete Support Personnel's and other groups' rights and responsibilities under the Code

Athlete Support Personnel Roles and Responsibilities

1. To be knowledgeable of and comply with all the anti-doping policies and rules adopted pursuant to the *Code* and which are applicable to them or the *Athletes* whom they support.
2. To cooperate with the *Athlete Testing* program.
3. To use their influence on *Athlete* values and behavior to foster anti-doping attitudes.
4. To disclose to the NADO and their International Federation any decision by a non-*Signatory* finding that they committed an anti-doping rule violation within the previous ten (10) years.
5. To cooperate with *Anti-Doping Organizations* investigating anti-doping rule violations.
6. *Athlete Support Personnel* shall not *Use* or *Possess* any *Prohibited Substance* or *Prohibited Method* without valid justification.

Roles and Responsibilities of Other Persons Subject to the Code

1. To be knowledgeable of and comply with all antidoping policies and rules adopted pursuant to the *Code* and which are applicable to them.
2. To disclose to their *National Anti-Doping Organization* and International Federation any decision by a non-*Signatory* finding that they committed an anti-doping rule violation within the previous ten (10) years.
3. To cooperate with *Anti-Doping Organizations* investigating anti-doping rule violations.

Roles and Responsibilities of Regional Anti-Doping Organizations

1. To ensure member countries adopt and implement rules, policies and programs which conform with the *Code*.
2. To require, as a condition of membership, that a member country sign an official *Regional Anti-Doping Organization* membership

form which clearly outlines the delegation of antidoping responsibilities to the *Regional Anti-Doping Organization*.

3. To cooperate with other relevant national and regional organizations and agencies and other *Anti-Doping Organizations*.
4. To encourage reciprocal *Testing* between *National Anti-Doping Organizations* and *Regional Anti-Doping Organizations*.
5. To promote and assist with capacity building among relevant *Anti-Doping Organizations*.
6. To promote anti-doping research.
7. To plan, implement, evaluate and promote antidoping *Education* in line with the requirements of the *International Standard for Education*.
